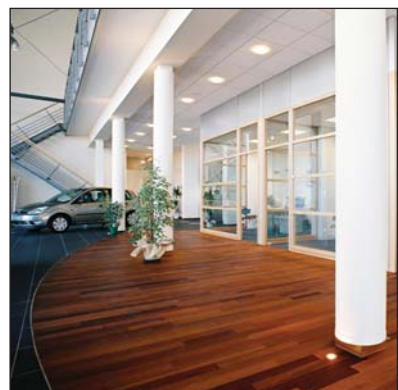

Description: Well defined sapwood light coloured to pale yellow (2 to 5cm) • Heartwood: Colour rich reddish-brown • Grain: Regular, occasional cross-grain with contrasting lighter features and deposits of yellow or white flecks • Tendency to turn a rich dark reddish - brown with age

Physical characteristics:

Density at 12% (Kg/cu m) MV12: 750 • Volumetric shrinkage for 1% of moisture v% = 0.44

Notes: Very good durability • Not vulnerable to lyctus beetle attack • Low impregnability • Good for nautical constructions
