Description: Sapwood dark to pinkish-grey - well defined. • Heartwood: Pink to Reddish Brown • Grain: Straight with light cross-grain, Fine silver grain (hardly visible) • Pearlished lustre on quarter

Physical characteristics:

Density of 12% (Kg/cu m) MV12: 800 • Volumetric shrinkage for 1% of moisture v% = 0.63

Notes: Very good durability • Not vulnerable to lyctus beetle attack • Low impregnability • Very high resistance to termite attack
